About the grant

The Australian Government's Play Our Way grant opportunity will **provide** greater opportunities for women and girls to access, participate and remain involved in sport and physical activity.

Funding streams:

- 1. Facilities: funding to support new and upgraded facilities, playing areas or spaces for sport and physical activity, specifically for women and girls.
- 2. Participation and equipment: funding to support sustainable and enduring sport participation programs, and/or new or upgraded equipment, specifically for women and girls.


- Applications close: 2pm Monday 29 April (AEST)

- Organisations are only able to apply for one application per stream

Framing your story

- Does your proposal align to the grant objectives?
- What data do you have to support your proposal?

Use data

- Demonstrate your needs
- Use various sources

Language

- Use concise and direct language
- Be persuasive

DEVELOPING A QUALITY APPLICATION



Assessment criteria

- Quality of the idea
- Local need
- Solution you propose
- Ensuring it will make a direct, positive difference to women and girls participating in sport and physical activity)
- Ensuring you can show a level of governance that will give the selectors confidence you can handle the money involved, and deliver the project with very little risk.

DEVELOPING A QUALITY APPLICATION



They have defined priority populations as those who:

- are First Nations peoples
- · are culturally and linguistically diverse
- have disability
- reside in regional, rural and remote areas (as defined by the Modified Monash Model, with areas classified in areas with MM3-7, the footnote on page 16 provides you with a link to the Model to allow you to understand your club location)
- reside in a low socioeconomic area and/or
- identify as belonging to the LGBTIQA+ community.

how your proposal provides **value for money** and will result in enduring change for women and girls facing barriers to participation in sport and physical activity, particularly those in **priority** populations

- The quality of the project proposal and activities
- Ability to contribute to government objectives
- That the absence of a grant is likely to prevent outcomes being achieved
- The applicants experience and performance history.

DEVELOPING A QUALITY APPLICATION



FACILITIES

- What is your project purpose and how much will it cost?
- Why is your project needed?
- Why you believe your organisation should get funded to deliver this project

PARTICIPATION AND EQUIPMENT

- Alignment with grant opportunity objectives
- Organisational capacity and project viability
- Inclusion
- Strategic alignment and engagement


DEMONSTRATING CAPABILITY






BUDGET

PERFORMANCE INDICATORS

- Have clear objectives
- How will you determine impact and success?



EXPERIENCE

- Showcase experience
- Commitment to Club Changer
- Strategic alignment



GETTING FEEDBACK





- Ask others to read your application internal or external to your application
- Double check responses respond to assessment criteria
- Ensure alignment to objectives
