

Hahn Australia Cup 2025

Streaming Preliminary Round Matches

1. Terms & Conditions

Section 26.4 of the Hahn Australia Cup 2025 Competition Regulations states:

FA has the sole and exclusive right to exploit any and all Media Rights in relation to the Hahn Australia Cup. No Hahn Australia Cup Participant or any third party may to any extent whatsoever exploit any Media Rights or parts thereof in relation to the Hahn Australia Cup, without FA's prior written approval in its sole and absolute discretion.

As such, any filming of Hahn Australia Cup Preliminary Round Matches must adhere to the following terms and conditions:

- a) Footage is not to be used or distributed for commercial use;
- b) Footage must contain the Hahn Australia Cup stack logo in the top right-hand corner of the vision;
- c) Any commentary/audio must abide by the Football Australia (FA) Code of Conduct;
- d) Content producer must alert/inform the home club prior to arrival at the venue; and
- e) Provide FA with the feed of the footage and/or highlights package within 48 hours of the match being completed. Or provide FA with a YouTube link on where the footage can be found.

2. Technical Requirements

Footage needs to adhere to the following specifications:

Wrapper: .mov (QuickTime Movie) or .mp4

Video Codec: H.264 (MPEG-4 Part 10) Main or High Profile Either Video Bit Rate: 3Mbps Constant (Minimum to 15 Mbps

(Maximum)

Or Video Compressor Quality: 85% or above (Maximum)
Video Frame Size (recommended): 1920x1080 (16:9 1080p HD)
Video Frame Size (minimum 16:9) 1280x270 (16:9 720p)

Video Frame Rate:50 fpsVideo Aspect Ratio:16:9

Audio Codec: AAC (Mpeg-4 Audio)

Audio Sample Size: 16bit

Audio Bit rate: 160Kbps 48 khz Stereo (Minimum)
Audio Bit rate: 256Kbps 48 khz Stereo (Maximum)

Progressive Encoding filter enabled, or source is deinterlaced before encoding.
